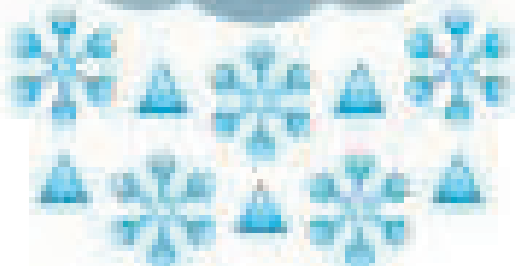


Learn how to
