

The program team and the board of directors have been concerned about life at RFS without a piano. Within a week of the grand piano's departure, we learned from Bobby Cleveland that the Cliffords were willing to give RFS a really fine piano. The piano was manufactured by the Poole company of Boston about 1913. How very appropriate that it should be a Poole Piano! Surely that would delight the heart of Avis Poole.
