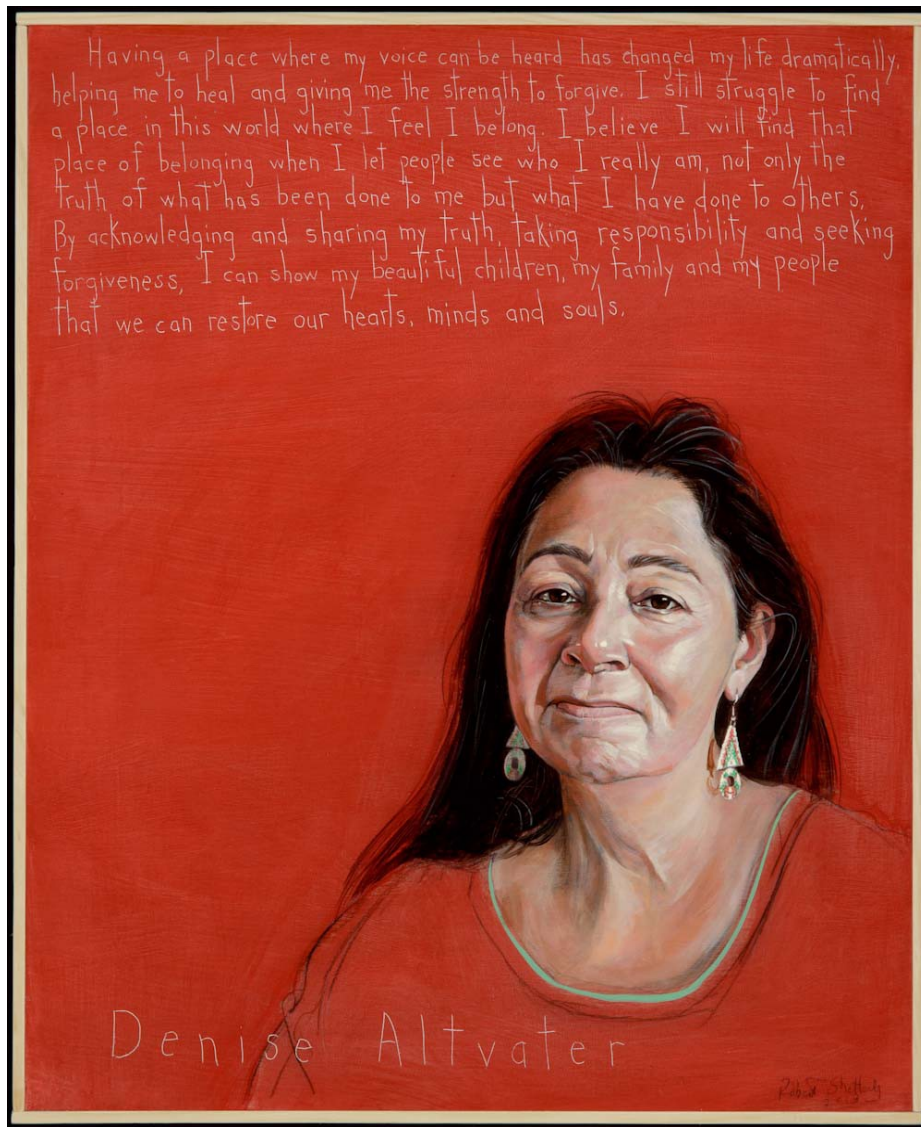
Reversing Falls Sanctuary Newsletter

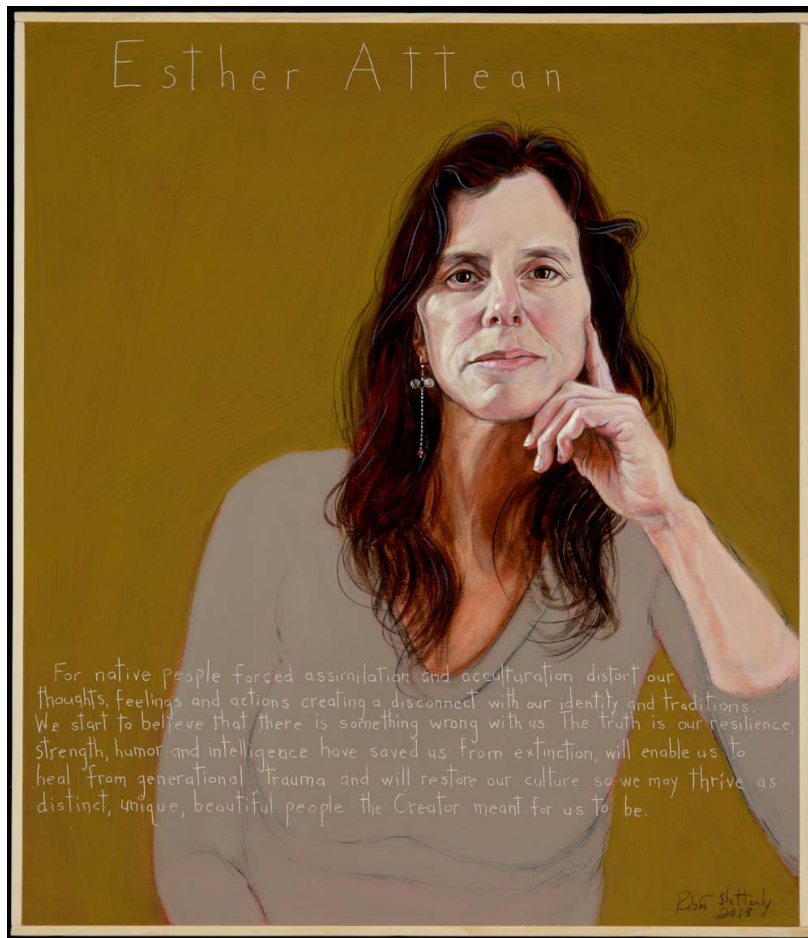
